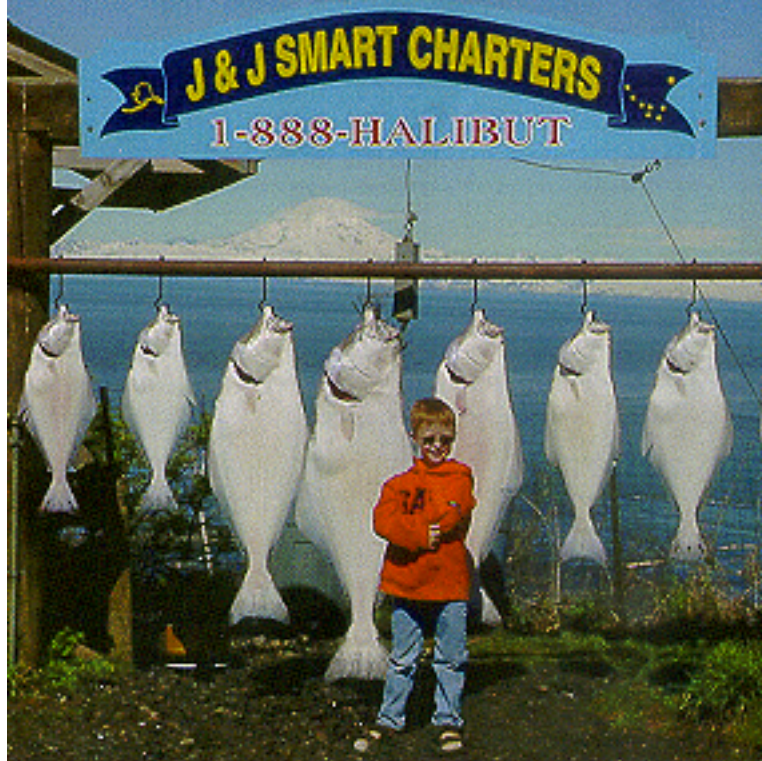

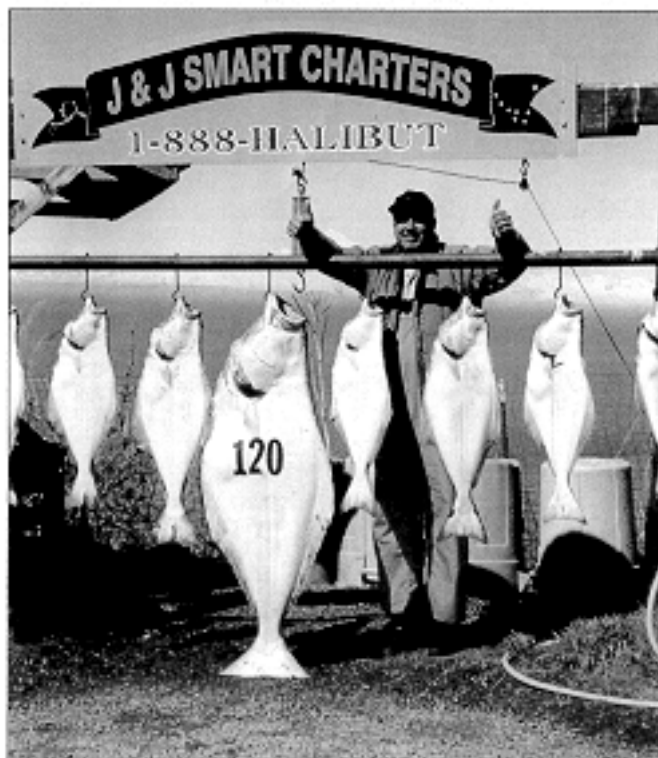

## Fishing Charters... Our Specialty

J&J Smart Charters is located on the world-famous Kenai Peninsula, with safe and comfortable 28-foot Alumaweld fishing boats that feature enclosed hard-top cabins for warmth, high sides for safety when fishing, private portable toilets in the cabin, and the latest in fish-finding gear, GPS, and marine communications. The safety equipment on board is Coast Guard approved and life vests are available for each person. A base station at our office in the campground keeps in touch with each boat while fishing, providing an additional safety factor.

We launch our boats out of Deep Creek in Ninilchik, a small rustic fishing village settled by Russian colonists in the early 1800s. Fishing gear and bait are provided along with Coast Guard licensed fishing guides and deckhands to bait the hooks and give you the benefit of their many years of fishing experience. Back at camp, we clean your catch at our fish cleaning facilities and have vacuum packing services available as well.

We are well known for having "fun" while we fish!

## Deep Creek View Campground...

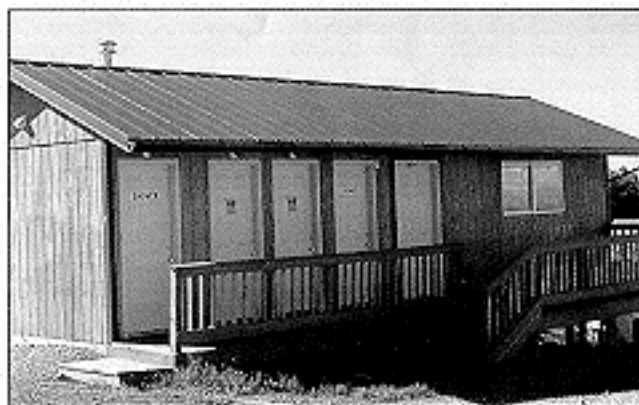

We provide free coffee and friendly service, so stop by and visit us!



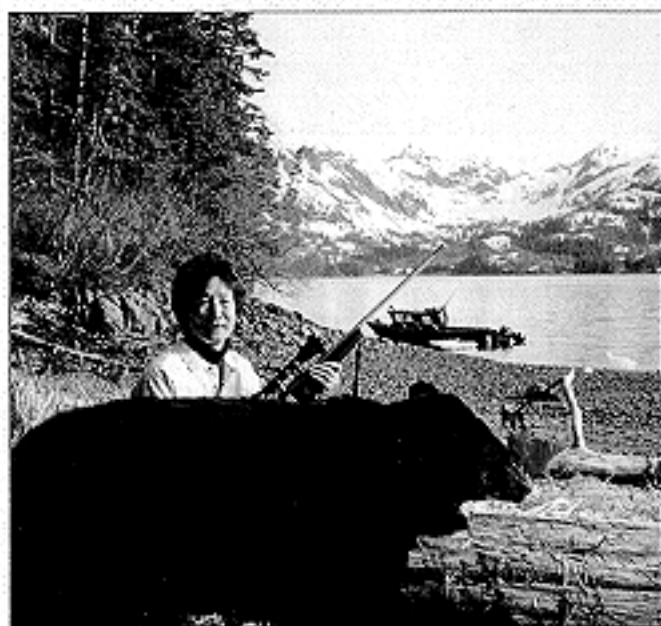
Let us coordinate your fishing adventure on the famous Kenai River.
